MFL

Guiding principles:

• We build knowledge over time. We use an EPI curriculum which intends to rehearse knowledge over time and build vocabulary and grammar through explicitly chunking knowledge. Whilst using retrieval practice and rehearsed knowledge to recap and retain knowledge.

Intent:

- We aim to teach a love of language and a joy in being able to speak another language by teaching pupils how to communicate, to understand the complexity of language, to understand grammar and how we recycle language (key structures) to communicate with others. By teaching another language we are teaching pupils to understand and relate better to their first language and develop tolerance, interest and understanding of others and their cultures.
- The curriculum is designed to build upon prior learning at KS2. The complexity of grammatical structure is systematically developed and revisited through age appropriate, engaging topics, tailored towards the GCSE syllabus. All students are challenged and supported to help them to develop their language learning skills in a secure environment. The grammatical knowledge and understanding, and vocabulary that students gain through our curriculum enables success at GCSE and a smooth transition to the demands of language study at KS5.
- Progress expectations are clearly defined in the pupil learning pathway (personalised learning standards) and all four skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) are assessed routinely.

Implementation:

- Sequenced well planned interleaved learning across the four skills.
- We have a building blocks curriculum which builds grammar and vocab from KS3 into KS4 through years 7-11. Focussing on non-negotiable structures
- We have integrated the three pillars of phonics, vocabulary and grammar throughout each module and key stage.

Impact:

- Our ultimate aim is to enable pupils to achieve their potential in the GCSE exams, these our assessment points from the start of KS3 consider the progress required to achieve this.
- The Key Stage 3 curriculum allows pupils to develop their speaking and listening, reading and writing skills. These skills are reflected upon as P progress through each module and assessed in each topic underpinned by an appropriate grammar progression grammar progression linked to the key assessment focus objectives in line with GCSE.
- Progress is regularly checked in class identifying misunderstandings or lack of understanding writing.
- Over the course of the Key Stage skills focus on preparing students for the demands of the GCSE, which is commenced part way through Year 9.
