Results and Progression

- 99.3% overall pass rate (3305 entries)
- Nearly 2000 high grades at A*-B awarded at A Level (58.2%, exceeding the national average of 53.6%)
- In excess of 20 students achieved a place at Oxbridge
- 26 of 36 courses have a 100% pass rate


