The High Sherriff of Shropshire, Jane Trowbridge, is championing a youth led initiative across Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin to raise awareness of the challenges facing our young people and to raise money to fund the local charities which are supporting them. This is an entirely youth led project, empowering young people of all ages to do something to help their generation, and giving them control, as they will decide the final distribution of all monies raised amongst their chosen local youth charities. Many of these charities are in critical need of extra funds due to cuts in grants and government funding. To support, this week on Thursday we will be taking part in the wear it blue day. This event is being supported across Shropshire and students are encouraged to wear something blue and donate a suggested amount of £1.00 to support the scheme.
